- ✓ Providing coaching to high potential/ talented players, most often aged 7 to 18 years. Also, support group coaching, 1-1 work and coaching at games across the ICCA's, Emerging Player Programme (EPP) and ICCA Performance Scholarship players (Scholars);
- ✓ Be the skill-set lead coach/ expert (batting, bowling, fielding, wicket keeping) for the ICCA EPP and ICCA Scholars and broader ICC Academy player development pathway;
- ✓ Identify, recruit and select EPP players and work closely with the Head of Cricket Development to enable them transition to high performance cricket and representative programmes.

Coordinating Fixtures.

- ✓ Responsible for organising and implementing a comprehensive programme of fixtures for identified ICCA squads and teams and using the outcomes to drive further player/ programme improvement;
- ✓ Liaise with all coaches and players to ensure that teams are organized and placed in appropriate leagues and events;
- ✓ Ensure all stakeholders are aware of fixtures and work closely with the operations team on ground availability;
- ✓ Organise and lead tour groups around the world;

One on One Coaching.

- ✓ Complete a minimum of 200 1-1 per year;
- ✓ Design and develop personalised one on one session plans using the best practice coaching principles;
- ✓ Integrate use of PitchVision and diverse technologies available into one on one sessions;

✓ Work closely with the Head of Cricket Development to gather and provide feedback regarding success of the ICCA cricket development programmes for the purpose of continual improvement. Prepare key documents related to the areas of work for review;

- ✓ A passion for excellence and self-development with a thirst for knowledge;
- ✓ Recognized First Aid qualification, child safeguarding certification and appropriate police record check;
- ✓ Proficiency in written and spoken English including the use of I.T. applications;

Desirable

- ✓ A recognized cricket coach education qualification or equivalent;
- ✓ Level 4 Coaching Qualification and/ or a Postgraduate qualification in coaching, teaching, sports science or pedagogy and/or an equivalent combination of education and experience;
